
STEVEN SCOTT

He has been showcased multiple times at the world famous Montreal "Just for Laughs" comedy festival, and currently serves on the Board of Governors of the famous Friars Club where he's performed, produced and participated in numerous club events. Recently Steven had the prestigious honor of Roasting Legendary funnyman Jerry Lewis at the club's annual Roast where many other celebrities from Robert DeNiro to Nathan Lane were also participants.

In addition to his personal appearances, Steven's work continues earning him numerous radio and television appearances. He's can often be seen on VH-1 series' like "I Love the 90's." He was a Semifinalist on the hit CBS show "Star Search," and has also appeared on various other programs for NBC, FOX, Comedy Central, MTV and more. He has performed on the Jerry Lewis MDA Telethon and proudly, served as a co-host of the annual Leukemia Society telethon in NY. He's also a co-host of a 26 channel interactive Internet programming site called MyEverything.com

Beyond his standup comedy, Steven actively pursues the acting side of his career. Recently he costarred in the critically acclaimed theatrical comedy "The Fartiste" which earned Best Musical at last years NY Fringe Festival. He has worked on a number of commercials, independent films, and has even appeared in a couple of major Hollywood blockbusters... but mostly in the "cutting room floor" scenes. He does tons of Voice Over work, for TV, commercials and video game characters. He has even had two studio holding deals... one of which was for Warner Brothers where he appeared as a series regular in a pilot for a hip sketch comedy show -- co-starring supermodel, actress and talk show host Tyra Banks and comedian and recent Academy Award Winning actor Jamie Foxx.
